### Special Remarks:

1. Minimum of 5 and maximum of 10 participants.
2. Songs/music need not be strictly from films, Fusion of songs may be used.
3. A maximum of 4 minutes (in total) to setup and clear out settings.
4. All materials brought to the stage shall be cleared and taken away from the Kalamela premises.

### Description of the Event:

Cinematic dance is the most popular form of group dance with inspiration from Indian Film Industry; this form does not stick to any rules and rigors. The body moves spontaneously and vigorously to the beat, celebrating the joy of celebration. Cinematic dance depicts the joys, passions, ardor, glow and fire of youth. The cinematic dance provides wholesome entertainment to all even if they have no aptitude for classical dance. It follows many Indian folk-dance steps and has certainly western elements too.
