3.	Musicality	Contestants ability to convey emotions and musical expression	15
4.	Tone Quality	Overall quality of the sound	10
5.	Interpretation	Contestants ability to convey composer's intention	10
6.	Rhythm and Timing		10
7.	Stage Presence		5
8.	Overall Artistry		10

### Special Remarks:

1. Contestant can perform a maximum of three pieces of contrasting styles.
2. No accompanying instrument is allowed
3. The setting time for the performance shall not exceed 3 minutes.

### Description of the Event:

Violins are important instruments in a wide variety of musical genres. They are most prominent in the Western classical tradition, both in ensembles and as solo instruments. Violins are also important in many varieties of folk music, including country music, bluegrass music, and in jazz. The violin has come to be incorporated in many non-Western music cultures, including Indian music and Iranian music.
